Materials like stained white oak, leather, antique bronze and blackened steel add varying textures and looks to the collection.

Standing out from the flock

Roxanne Flick's **Purpur** collection shows how nature can be adapted to design. Inspired by the lesser flamingos, their visual appearance, behaviour and bodily functions, the collection comprises a table and a tea set. The table, made of wood, granite and glass, represents a lake and the porcelain pieces represent the flamingos. The size, shape and palette are all based on the appearance of the birds. Flick's main idea was to personify an inanimate object and adapt it to suit a live form in an abstract way.



Vanity, justified

To add a dash of starkness to your bathroom, opt for the **Side Honey Vanity Unit** in its signature Silent Night blue colour. A product of Swoon, the honeycomb-patterned unit is made in both black and white ash. Standing high on thin legs, it has a large soft-closing drawer with full extension, and a compartment for storage of smaller items, both with matte black knobs.
